## Maths (White Rose Maths)

In the first term of Year 2, we will begin by revising some of the key mathematical concepts learnt in Year 1 before advancing to build on our number and place value knowledge. We will be developing our understanding of the four operations.

- Number: Number & Place
   Value
- o Number: Addition & Subtraction
- o <u>Measurement:</u> Money
- o Number: Multiplication & Division

We will be using 'concrete' resources to help demonstrate key concepts and engaging in practical tasks, where possible. We will also be applying what we have learnt to reasoning and problem solving tasks.

### <u>Literacu</u>

Our main areas of focus in writing this term will be ensuring neat handwriting; accurate use of capital letters and full stops; and correct spelling of the Years 1 and 2 Common Exception Words. We will explore a variety of different text types linked to our topic in order to give plenty of opportunity to practise these skills.

- o Story Writing Toby and the Great Fire of London
- o <u>Instructions</u> Tudor Houses, bread making
- o <u>Diary entry</u> Samuel Pepys, Guy Fawkes
- o Poetry fireworks, the environment, Remembrance
- o <u>Letters</u> the letter that exposed the Gunpowder Plot
- Newspaper Reports Gunpowder Plot/Great Fire of London

In addition, we will undertake our first module from 'The Write Stuff' – a tried and tested system for encouraging successful writing that is being used across the school.

In reading, we will be working hard to develop our fluency, to read with expression and begin to develop key comprehension skills. Phonics revision will take place before children are introduced to spelling rules and patterns.

## Topic (History/Geography)

Our 'Fire, Flames and Festivals' topic will explore different aspects of 17<sup>th</sup> Century London.

o The Great Fire of London (1666): Children will learn about



the key events of the Great Fire of London, and develop an understanding of the ways in which we can find out about the past

through discussing primary sources. They will be introduced to Samuel Pepys and his famous diary. There will be an opportunity to increase their awareness of the past by comparing and contrasting past and present-day London, as well as looking at how life was different in the 17<sup>th</sup> century.

(This topic Includes a trip to the Tower of London and a special visit to the school by representatives from Surrey Fire and Rescue.)

 The Gunpowder Plot (1605): Children will find out about Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder Plot. They will learn why we should always 'remember, remember the 5<sup>th</sup> November' and understand how bonfire night is celebrated in Britain.

#### Science

The two main topics we will be covering in Science this term are:

- Uses of Everyday Materials with a particular focus on recycling and reusing materials.
- The Environment the challenges being faced by our world and the action we can take to mitigate them.
