HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

As a School we aim to

- ◆ Provide a broad, balanced education in accordance with the National Curriculum, with equal opportunities for all in a Christian setting which is caring and friendly;
- ◆ Create a smooth transition from home/pre-school activity into school life
- ◆ Build self-esteem and mutual respect so that pupils are motivated to learn
- ◆ Recognise and reward success and achievement
- ◆ Establish a code of behaviour to ensure a safe and caring environment
- ◆ Contact parents if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or equipment;
- ◆ Let parents know about special achievement and progress being made by their child;
- ◆ Let parents know about any concerns or problems affecting their child's work or behaviour;
- ◆ Set, mark and monitor homework suitable for each particular year group;
- ◆ Arrange parents' consultation evenings in order to discuss individual children's progress;
- ◆ Arrange meetings for parents to share information about the curriculum or general school matters;
- ◆ Keep parents informed about school activities through regular letters home and notices about school events;
- ◆ Be open and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for parents to become involved in the life of the school;
- ◆ Make the file of School Policies available in the School Office for parents to consult on request.

As a Parent/Guardian I/we aim to

- ◆ Encourage my/our child to take part in the full life of the School
- ◆ Ensure that my/our child attends school regularly, on time, in the correct uniform and with everything s/he needs
- ◆ Encourage my/our child to take a pride and interest in his/her work at home as well as at school
- ◆ Support the School's Behaviour Policy
- ◆ Regularly attend parents' meetings and support extra-curricular activities when/where possible
- ◆ Communicate with the school regarding anything which may affect my/our child's progress or welfare.
- ◆ Seek permission in advance before taking my/our child out of school for reasons other than illness or emergency;
- ◆ Provide a note of explanation if my/our child is absent;
- ◆ Let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my/our child's work or behaviour;

- ◆ Take opportunities to become involved in my/our child's education and in the life of the school;
