## Nativity Play: 'Away On a Silent Night'

I am delighted to announce that nativity performances will take place on **Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup>** (dress rehearsal), **Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> and Friday 12<sup>th</sup> December**. Year 2 children will take the lead in these performances, accompanied by children from Year 1 and Reception.

Here is a simple outline of costumes for each role:

**Innkeepers:** Long tunics with belts, headdresses and aprons.

**Mary:** White dress, blue apron/ cloak, headdress.

**Joseph:** Long tunics with belts, headdresses and aprons.

**Angels:** Angel outfits – tunics and white tights.

**Shepherds:** Long tunics with belts/ dressing gown, headdresses. A staff or stick is optional.

**Attendants:** Long tunics with belts, headdresses and aprons.

**Kings:** Bright robes, capes and crowns.

**Travellers:** Long tunics with belts, cloaks or shawls, headdresses, simple bags or satchels, wooden sticks.

**Cesar:** Long white tunic, gold belt, red/ purple drape, laurel wreath

**The Chief Advisor:** Long white tunic with belt

Hopefully, you can find the items at home – please don't feel compelled to go out and buy expensive items. If you are unable to source any items, please could you let the class teacher know as soon as possible and we will do our best to provide something from the school's costume cupboard.

Please could the children bring their costumes to school in a named bag by **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> December**.
