

Purchase items for your class teachers with Amazon wishlists.





School Bulletin Email — fortnightly on Thursday. Important diary dates, date changes and notices regarding school arrangements.

Seesaw — teachers to share children's learning and quick class reminders.

Email — communication to parents inbetween bulletins.

Diary dates, letters and bulletins are published on the school website.

Texts – immediate communication e.g. when a trip is running late

Diary Dates — end of each term for the following term. By email.

WhatsApp Groups – set up informally by parents, used to share class reminders between parents. Plus PTA requests.

Letters — specific class arrangements eg trips, sports tournaments. Sent by email.
