Re: Y4 Swimming Lessons: Monday 19th January, Monday 26th January and Monday 2nd February, at 1:30-2:15pm

During the Spring term we have arranged three swimming lessons for your child at Waverley Abbey Junior School. Each session will be taught by a qualified instructor from Fun Flippers Swimming. The lessons will take place on **Monday 19**th **January, Monday 26**th **January and Monday 2**nd **February, at 1:30-2:15pm.**

Your child must bring a suitable swimming costume (no bikinis or long shorts), towel and goggles in a named bag. There will be no time for hair washing after the lesson.

The children will leave St Mary's at 12:50pm and they will be accompanied by school staff. They will be travelling by coach. We will be back at St Marys, traffic permitting, at approximately 3:00pm. Please bear with us if we are a little late returning and ensure you make any necessary arrangements in advance in case the coach is delayed. If we anticipate a late return, you will be notified by text message.

The cost of all three lessons will be £35 for which we need to ask all parents for a voluntary contribution. This also includes transport to and from the school. Please can I ask you make the payments by **Friday 19**th **December.**

We want every child to enjoy the full range of trips and experiences at St Mary's. If the cost of this trip presents a challenge, please don't hesitate to reach out to Mrs Evans or the admin team **in confidence**.
