Maths (White Rose Maths)

In the third term of Year 2, we will be looking at the following areas:

- Geometry: Position and Direction
- Measurement: Time
- Measurement: Mass, Capacity and Temperature

We will be getting outside wherever possible to apply our mathematical learning practically. By applying key principles to real-life scenarios, we hope to demonstrate the importance and relevance of the subject in everyday life. During the second part of the term, we will go back and revise all of the year 2 areas and assess the children's learning in preparation for the transition to Yr 3.

Science

The topics we will be covering in Science this term include:

- Plants
- The brilliant life of bees
- Scientists and inventors

To support our learning about plants, we will be planting our own seeds/bulbs and visiting RHS Garden Wisley.



Computing

- Media We will be looking at photography exploring what makes a good photograph, lighting, effects.
- IT skills We will further develop our IT skills including typing and designing using a range of programs. We will also look at how IT is used in school and around the world.

Literacu

Our main focus in writing this term will be on developing positive attitudes and stamina for writing by producing pieces about real events, stories, poems and writing for other purposes. Writing will be carefully planned using purposefully gathered vocabulary to help build solid, grammatically correct sentences with well-chosen punctuation.

In reading, we will continue to work on developing our fluency and expression. In addition to this, we will further develop our written comprehension skills focussing specifically on inference and prediction. As a class, we will spend time reading books such as "The Boy Who Grew Dragons" and "Charlie and the Chocolate Factory" and responding to these texts in a range of different ways.

In spelling, we will continue with the Read Write Inc. Spelling Programme to learn different spelling rules and patterns, consolidated with weeklu homework.

Topic (Art/Design & Technology)
