

#### Maths

Following the White Rose scheme of learning, we will be learning about:

- Place Value
- Addition & Subtraction
- Area
- Multiplication & Division (A)



#### English

In writing, we will be exploring and developing our understanding of the ideas, grammar and techniques of writing using 'The Writing Rainbow'. Each unit of work will be followed by an independent write where we will apply the skills we have learnt in our sentence stacking lessons.

- Narrative (Fantasy) based on Shaun Tan's 'The Lost Thing'.
- Non-fiction recount.
- Poetry Summer Holiday; Heritage Week

In addition to becoming more fluent and expressive readers, we will be developing our comprehension skills as we focus on both reading for pleasure and reading for information.

#### Science

The topics we will be covering in Science this term include:

- <u>States of Matter</u> through a series of lessons, children will explore the key question 'Can materials change state?'.
- Electricity children will learn about common electrical appliances and how to construct simple series circuits. They will become familiar with the key words linked to the topic and how to apply them appropriately. Children will learn about cells, wires, bulbs and buzzers and about the different types of switches. They will be able to troubleshoot and identify whether or not a bulb will light in a simple series circuit and be able to identify a complete circuit. The children will also learn about conductors and insulators and know that metals are very good electrical conductors.

#### <u> History</u>

Vikings - children will explore what image we have of the Vikings; why they have gained such a bad reputation; learn how they tried to take over the country and how close they got; consider how recent excavations have changed our view of the Vikings; think about what we can learn about Viking settlement from a study of place-name endings, and ponder how we should remember the Vikings - raiders or settlers?
