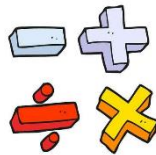


**Maths**

We will begin this term by ensuring secure knowledge of our times tables and related division facts before using these to develop written multiplication and division methods. We will also explore area, develop our understanding of fractions, and be introduced to decimals.

- Number: Multiplication & Division
- Measurement: Length and Perimeter
- Number: Fractions
- Number: Decimals



We will also be applying our learning to reasoning and problem solving tasks.

**English**

In writing, we will continue using 'The Writing Rainbow'.to explore and develop our understanding of the ideas, grammar and techniques of writing.

- Non-Fiction – Hatshepsut (Biography)
- Fiction – Egyptian Cinderella
- Poetry - Still I Rise

In the Spring Term, we will continue the Year 4 Read Write Inc Spelling Programme alongside revision of the Y1 & 2 Common Exception Words and Y3/4 statutory spellings.

In addition to becoming more fluent and expressive readers we will be developing our comprehension skills as we focus on both reading for pleasure and reading for meaning.

**Topic (History)**

In this Ancient Egypt topic, the children will learn in depth about the achievements of this ancient civilisation. They will learn about how and where the ancient Egyptians lived, what was important to the daily lives of ancient Egyptians, who Tutankhamun was and how mummies were made. The children will also learn about how Egyptian people used hieroglyphs to communicate and compare the powers of different gods.



**Science**

The topics we will be covering in Science this term include:
