

## YEAR 5 MEDIUM TERM PLAN – SUMMER 2023

### Maths (White Rose Maths)

In the third term of Year 5, we will be looking at the following areas:

- Statistics: line graphs and tables
- Shape: angles, polygons and 3D shapes
- Position and direction: using co-ordinates, lines of symmetry
- Decimals: add and subtract decimals
- Measurement: converting units

We will look for opportunities to apply our mathematical learning practically. By applying key principles to real-life scenarios, we hope to demonstrate the importance and relevance of the subject in everyday life. During the second part of the term, we hope to go back and revise all of the year 5 areas and assess the children's learning in preparation for the transition to Yr 6.

### Science

The term we will be focussing on the topic 'Living Things and their Habitats'. This will include:

- Reproduction in plants
- Life cycles of mammals
- Metamorphosis
- Gestation periods, babies and puberty



### Literacy

Our main focus in reading this term will be on building stamina and developing a range of skills necessary to be successful in demonstrating comprehension, such as inference, prediction and summarising the text. Our class novel 'Treason' will give us the opportunity to immerse ourselves in the Tudor period and analyse the characters presented by author, Berlie Doherty.

Much of our writing will be in response to the events within this novel although we will take regular breaks to look at pieces about real events, poems and writing for other purposes. Writing will be carefully planned using purposefully gathered vocabulary to help build solid, grammatically correct sentences with well-chosen punctuation.

In spelling, we will continue with the Read Write Inc. Spelling Programme to learn different spelling rules and patterns.

### Topic

This term, we are really excited to be exploring the topic 'The Tudors'. We will begin by looking at the Tudor family tree, tracking the monarchs through from the beginning to the end of this fascinating period in history.

We will spend some time looking at the reign of King Henry VIII and the various fates of his six wives. This will also be the subject of a Year 5 class assembly.

Once we have dealt with the monarchy, we will move on to look at the Tudor society: rich and poor, crime and punishment, illness and medicine, food and clothing of the times. The Topic will culminate with a Tudor banquet!

### Art & Design Technology

Children will use a range of different media to produce artwork/items linked to our topic. Projects will include:

- Tudor portraits
- Pencil portraits of King Charles III
- 3D Tudor roses
- Illuminated lettering in a Tudor style



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### Computing

Using Purple Mash, the children will continue to explore the effective use of databases. In addition we will look at:

- Spreadsheets
- E-safety and being vigilant online

### PE

Our outdoor PE lessons will include:

- Rounders
- Tennis

Our indoor activities will include: gymnastics, dance and personal fitness

### PSHE

Using the Jigsaw scheme of work, this term we will be covering:

- Healthy me
- Relationships
- Changing Me
- The transition to Year 6

The children will learn independent living skills during our residential trip to High Ashurst in June.

### RE

This term we will discuss:

- What is a creed?
- How can churches help us to understand the Christian belief?
- What would Jesus do?
- How do the beliefs of Christians influence their actions?

### French

This term, the children will be learning vocabulary relating to:

- Fruit and vegetables
- Visiting the café
- Bastille Day Celebrations

### Music

This term, we will be learning songs for our class assembly.

We will also be learning songs to support the Year 6 production.
