Maths

In addition to becoming more fluent and expressive readers we will be developing our comprehension skills as we focus on both reading for pleasure and reading for meaning.

Topic (History)

In this topic, the children will learn when and why World War II began, and find out about the key individuals and countries involved. In addition to this, they will discover what it was like for people on the home front and how they contributed to the war effort. They will also learn all about the roles and responsibilities of the men and women who served in the British armed forces: explore the significance of the Battle of Britain; participate in wartime songs, dances and games and develop a sense of awareness and appreciation when learning about different commemorative events. Studying WWII will help the children to develop their investigation and evaluation skills; learn to organise information chronologically and understand how past events have

helped to shape the world we know

today.
