<p>Lesson</p>	<p><b>RE</b></p> <p>This half term our RE unit is titled "How did Jesus change Lives?"</p> <p><b><u>Lesson two</u></b></p> <p><i>How did Jesus change lives?</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>This week we will focus on the fact that Jesus befriended not only ordinary people like fishermen, or the blindman but the 'outcasts' of society for example the tax collector Zacchaeus.</b></li></ul> <p>Look at the power point of Zacchaeus. Whilst looking through this please think about how Jesus changed his life - what was he like after Jesus came to his house? 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- How does it feel to be a part of God's family?
- What did you do to make up for all the bad things you did?
