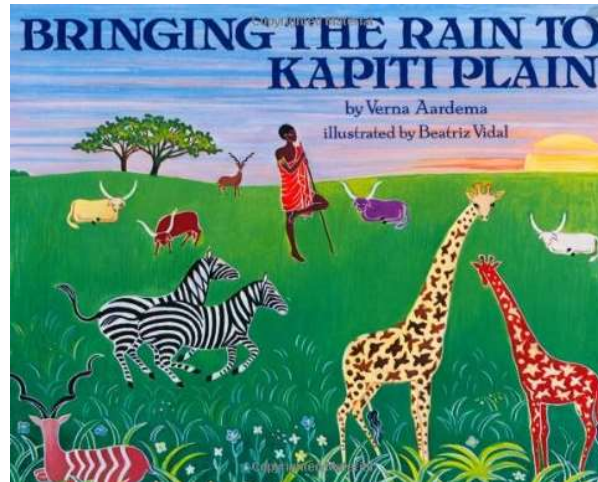


## Kenyan Tales – Bringing the Rain to Kapiti Plain

2. How did you feel about the drought? What were your concerns?
3. Describe the cloud that loomed overhead.
4. Explain the arrival of the eagle feather and what you decided to do with it.
5. What happened when you fired the feather at the cloud?
6. What effect did this have on the land and the animals?
7. How do you feel now?

Success criteria for this task:

- Describe the events in the correct order using past tense.
- You are writing as Ki-pat so make sure you use 'I'
- Capital letters and full stops.
- Neat handwriting.
- Try to include some conjunctions (linking words) such as because, when, but, yet, so, and.
