



Lent Collaborative Art Project

Over the next few weeks, we would like to run a collaborative art project as a way of celebrating Lent together and decorating the doors of our classrooms on the approach to Easter.

The idea is for each class to create a large cross formed from photos and artwork that the children have created. The theme will be crosses or hearts, or you could choose a symbol that is important to your family. When completed, the cross will be displayed on classroom doors and will show the things that are important to us.

There are almost unlimited ways you could approach this project. Your child could make a heart or cross from playdough or Lego; you could create some natural artwork as a family on a walk; you could cook a favourite dish and decorate it with a cross or heart or other symbol; your child or family could draw or paint a picture of the symbol you choose.

The only criteria are that we need a **photo** of the artwork and that the symbol will need to **stand out clearly** in the photo so that when it is printed out it will be very visible. (Please see the examples shown on the left.) Please send a clear photo to your teacher via Seesaw by Friday 5th March so we can print them out to make the crosses. Have fun!
