Did you know in every French municipality; the mayor can honour mothers of large families by giving them a special medal called "Médaille de la Famille" (Family Medal). The tradition is generally held annually on Mother's Day. Mothers can receive a gold medal if they have more than eight children, a silver medal if they have six or seven children, and a bronze medal if they have four or five children!

We think all your Mum's deserve a medal so as it is wellbeing Wednesday why not get prepared today and make a French Mother's Day card and medal or a bracelet?
