

<p><b>Maths</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Number and Place Value within 50</li> <li>• Addition and Subtraction within 20</li> <li>• Measurement – length, weight and capacity</li> </ul> <p>We will make cross curricular links where possible, for example measuring milk in litres or wool in centimetres.</p>	<p><b>English</b></p> <p><b>Information Page-</b> We will be learning about different animals that provide us with food and we will be using the information to create non-fiction texts.</p> <p><b>Picture Inspired Writing-</b> We will be using storytelling picture prompts to encourage independent writing. This will help them to develop their skills when re-reading and editing their own work.</p> <p><b>Phonics –</b> We will begin by reviewing sounds learnt to date. We will continue to learn further sounds as well as the high frequency words required in Year 1. The learning of phonics will be linked to both reading and spelling.</p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>As scientists we will be studying how the seasons change and describing weather associated with the seasons. We will link this to our topic by considering how the weather affects our food.</p>
<p><b>Topic</b></p> <p>Our topic will provide opportunities to develop our skills, particularly Science, DT and Art. We will be looking at where our food comes from and how it makes its way to our plates. We will discover how the seasons help farmers to provide us with food. We will find out about farm animals look at how they help us. We will also look at farming in the past and how things have changed.
